# Olam Agri Edible Oils Business Overview

Olam Agri operates three edible oils refineries in Africa, two located in Mozambique and one in Nigeria. These refineries primarily function as destination refineries and serve local market. All our refineries have achieved RSPO Supply Chain Certification System (SCCS) certification.

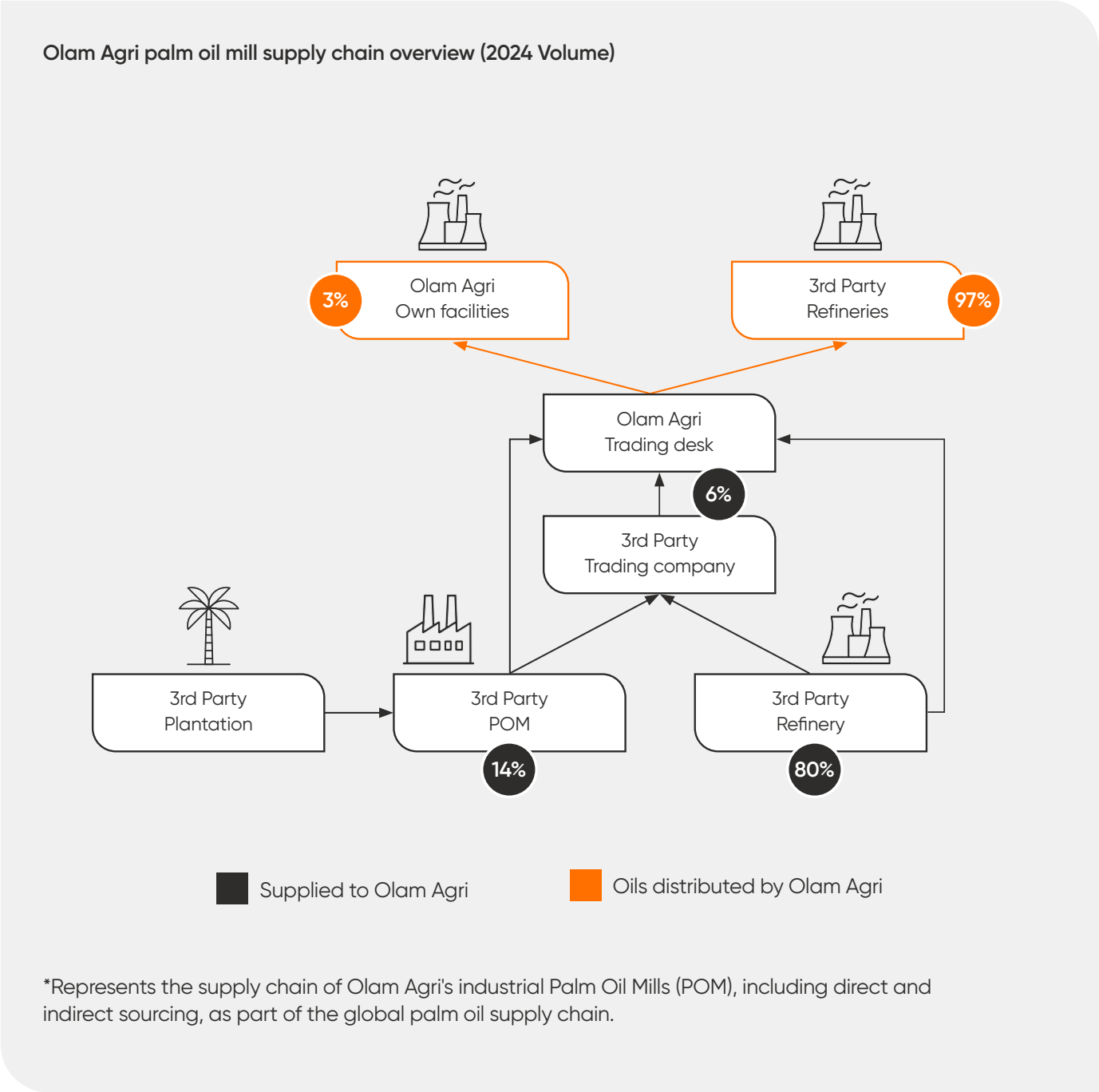

# Supply Chain Structure

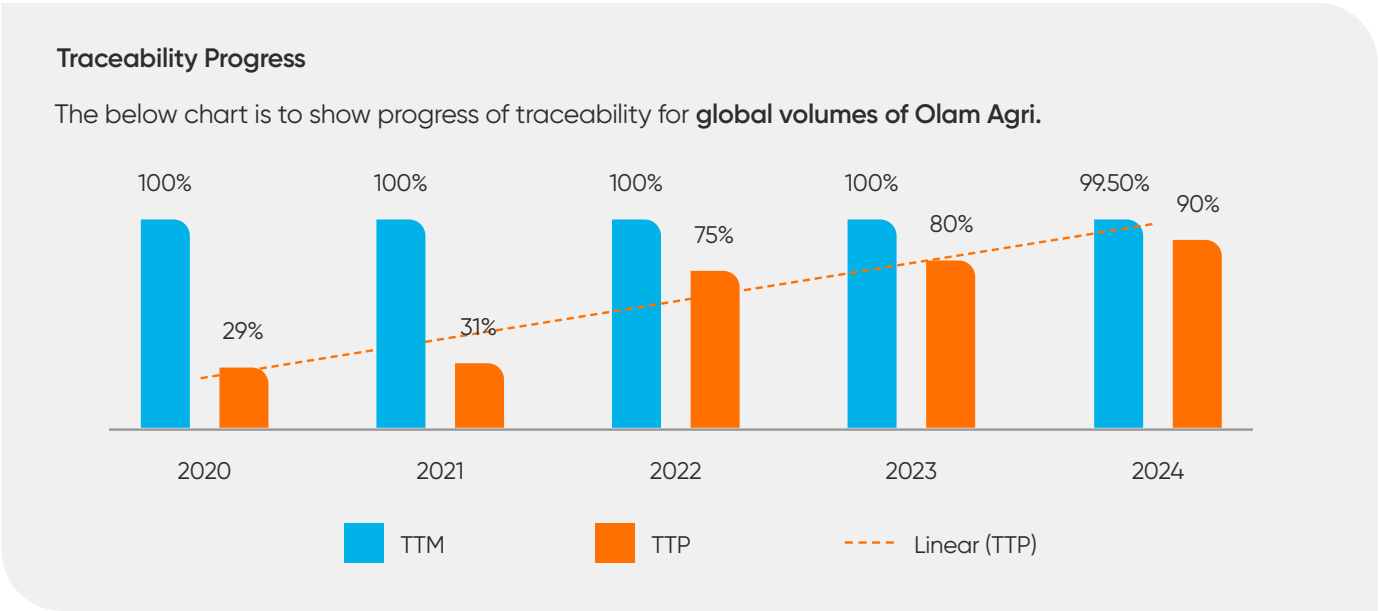


# Transparency and Traceability

We transparently report all our palm oil volume, which include volumes from our own refineries as well as traded volumes. The traded volumes also include volumes that are not physically processed in our own facilities but rather we act as an intermediary seller – buying from one party and selling to another.

We have maintained 100% traceability to mill (TTM) since 2020, however in 2024 volume we have dropped our TTM to 99,5% due to the volume we have purchased from downstream suppliers. We have recorded 1396 palm oil mills in our supply chain in 2024.

Despite this, we have maintained an increase in our traceability to plantation (TTP) score, covering all our traded volumes, which we proceed physically in our facilities and the pass-through volume.



As a milestone in 2024, all our direct sourcing from the mills in Indonesia, where we have direct leverage to drive engagement, has achieved 100% TTP.

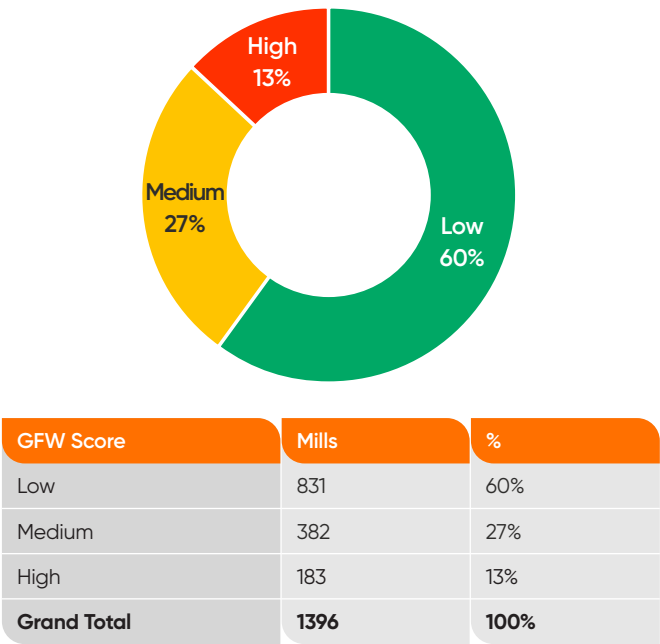

## Mill Risk Rating

100% of our direct suppliers have complied with Olam Agri's Responsible Sourcing Palm Oil Policy & Olam Agri Supplier Code.

## GFW Risk Score

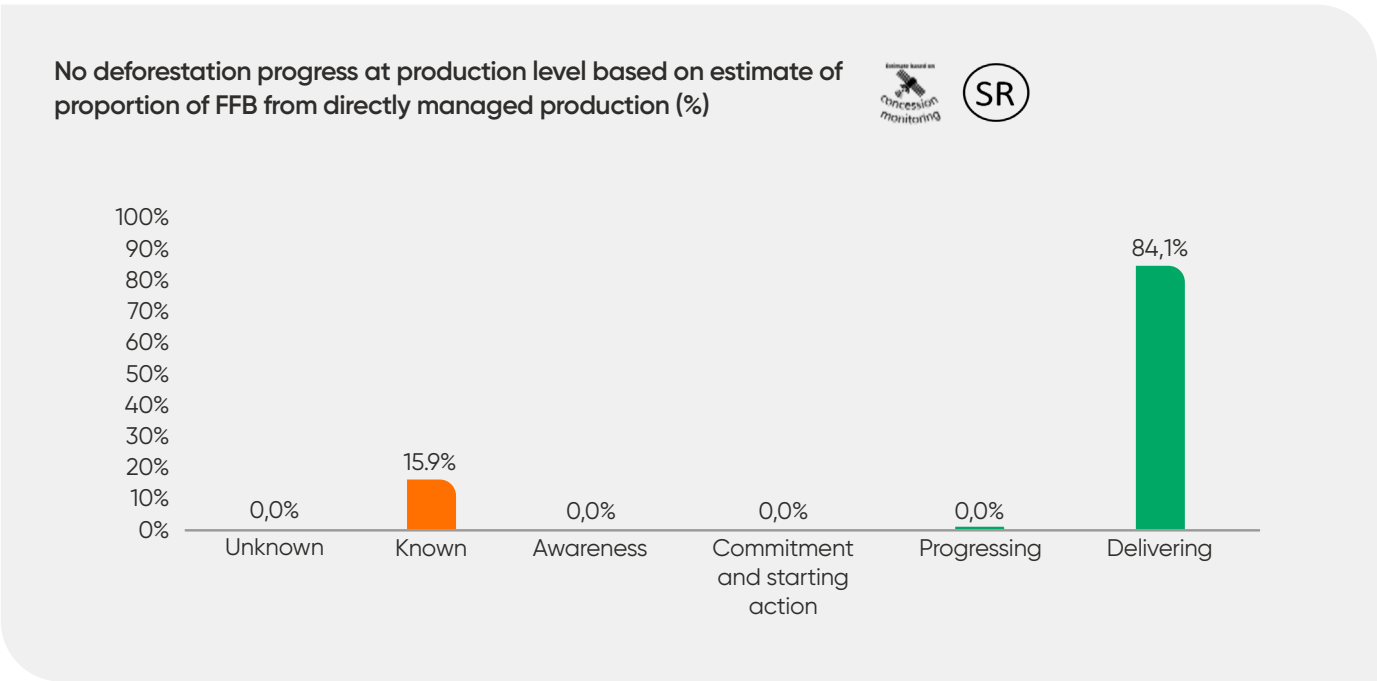

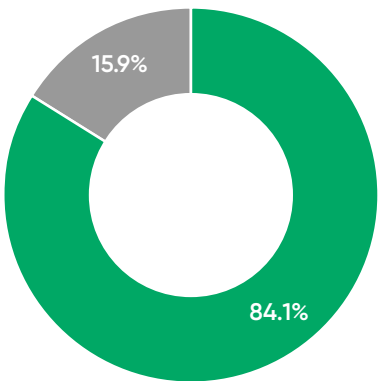

## No Deforestation Profile

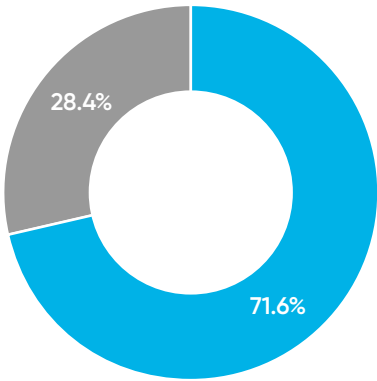


Estimated percentage deforestation-free FFB



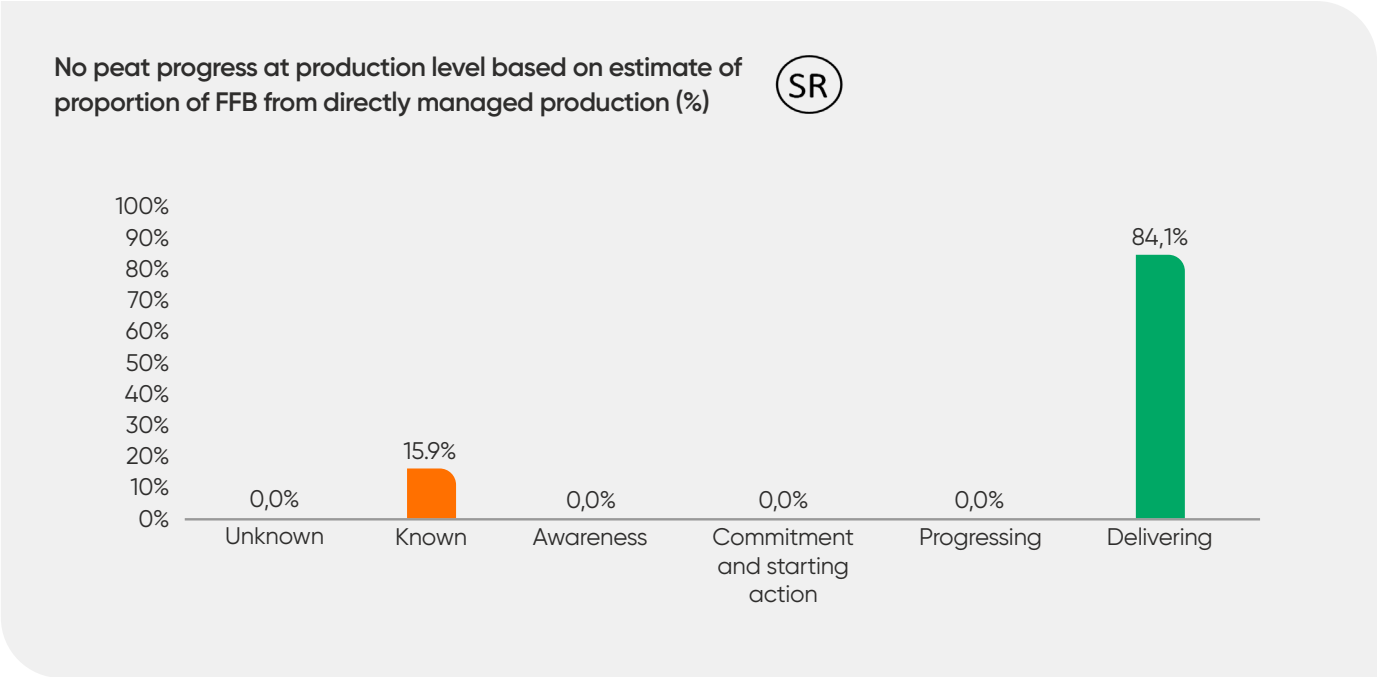

IRF Profile Verification Status Breakdown (No Deforestation)

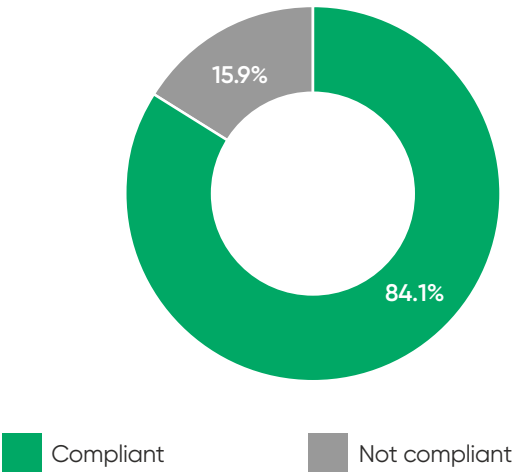

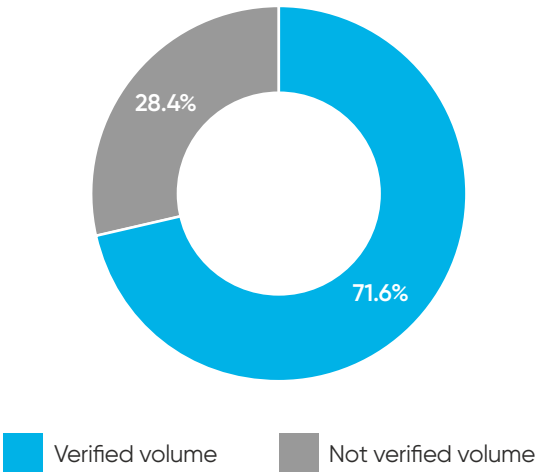
No Peat Profile
